

Family Support Services

What is Family Support Service?

Family Support Service provides support to an individual (ages 3 or older) and their family to meet the excess care needs related to individual's disability so they can remain in their home.

The support provides **Respite/Relief Care** when the primary caregiver(s) **is/are not present** or...

The support provides supervision when the primary caregiver(s) **is/are not present** due to attending work or school or...

The support provides a second pair of hands to assist the person receiving support with activities of daily living and maintaining the health and safety of the individual when the primary caregiver is **present** (asleep or awake).

What Makes it so Special?

The GFGSC Family Support Services (FSS) team provides personalized one-on-one support 24 hours a day. Staff help individuals build meaningful relationships, participate in their communities, and gain greater independence, while also providing respite and support for primary caregivers.

This service is available to individuals of all ages with disabilities who live with their family or guardian.
